



CAREER NOTES: Three-time All-American • is the fourth-fastest performer in school history in the 100 butterfly (47.13) and 20th in the 200 IM (1:49.20) • part of 200 medley relay team that broke Big Ten record to win conference title at 2009 Big Ten Championships • 2008 Olympic Trials qualifier.

2008-09 • SENIOR SEASON: Earned All-America honors on the 200 and 400 medley relays • swam the fly leg on the 13th-place 400 medley relay and ninth-place 200 medley relay • competed at second NCAA Championships • posted career-best times in all three individual events at the Big Ten Championships • reached first Big Ten championship final, taking eighth in the 100 butterfly • went a 47.13 in the prelims, which ranks as the fourth-fastest ever in the event • swam the fly leg of the Big Ten champion and record-breaking 200 medley relay that won in 1:24.41 • went a career-low 44.19 in the prelims of the 100 free to finish 18th • also placed 20th in the 200 IM in a career-best 1:49.20 • won two events during the regular season • took second in the 100 fly at North Carolina and against Iowa • won the 100 butterfly at Hawaii • clocked a lifetime-best 48.35 in the 100 fly at the Ohio State Invitational to finish second • touched first in the 100 fly in Gopher win at Washington • Academic All-Big Ten • letterwinner.

2007-08 • JUNIOR SEASON: Reached first NCAA Championships as part of the 200 medley relay team • earned All-America honors • made second Big Ten Championships appearance • scored at Big Tens for the first time in his career, placing 16th in the 100 butterfly • posted career-best times in three events at Big Tens • swam the fly leg of the Gophers third place 200 medley relay team at Big Tens • finished 30th in the 200 fly and 33rd in the 200 IM • picked up a win in the 100 butterfly at the Minnesota Challenge in 49.55 • made strong showing at 2008 U.S. Open, placing 12th in the 100-meter fly in 54.23 • Academic All-Big Ten • letterwinner.

2006-07 • SOPHOMORE SEASON: Made first Big Ten Championships appearance • made the Bonus Final of the 100 butterfly after a career-best time of 49.15 in the prelims • ended up 20th with a time of 49.63 • also finished 30th in the 200 individual medley (1:51.77) and 34th in the 200 butterfly (1:53.79) • placed fourth in the 100 fly and fifth in the 200 IM at the Minnesota Challenge (1/26-27) • finaled in the 100 fly at the Ohio State Invitational, finishing sixth • posted a sixth place finish in the 100 fly at the Minnesota Invitational • Academic All-Big Ten • letterwinner.

2005-06 • FRESHMAN SEASON: Won the consolation final of the 200 IM at the Minnesota Invitational (11/18) in 1:54.91 • also placed 13th in the 100 fly at the Minnesota Invite • clocked a season-best time of 1:54.37 to finish fifth in the 200 IM at the Minnesota Challenge (2/3) • also posted a season-best 50.89 to finish fifth in the 100 fly at the Minnesota Challenge.

HIGH SCHOOL: A 2005 graduate of Lawrence Free State High School (Kan.) • six-time individual Kansas State High School champion • won the 100 butterfly title as a senior and junior • also won the 200 individual medley state crown as a senior • led Lawrence Free State to 2005 Kansas team title • first team all-state swimmer all four years • holds eight school records including five individual events • named the Lawrence Journal World Athlete of the Year for 2003-04 • honor roll student • owns top times of 51.34 (100 fly), 1:55.07 (200 IM) and 1:43.84 (200 free) • competed on same club team (Lawrence Aquahawks) as Gopher sophomore Tyler Schmidt.
